Seaport and Rail Yard Areas Emissions Reduction 2024

Due: March 4, 2025

Program budget: \$20 million



Eligible projects:

Eligible projects include the replacement of Class 7, 8a, and 8b heavy-duty drayage trucks with a GVWR over 26,000lbs that operate in one or more of the designated seaports or rail yards for a minimum of 200 days per year for the preceding two years. Up to 10 activities may be included in each grant application. Separate applications must be submitted for projects that operate in different primary areas. Scrappage is required.

Eligible applicants:

Individuals, corporations, organizations, governments or governmental subdivisions or agencies, or any other legal entity including those who have a corporation headquartered outside of Texas that operates eligible equipment in Texas.

Funding cap per vehicle:

Replacement projects may be eligible up to 80% of the eligible costs associated with the purchase or lease of the replacement equipment. Eligible costs will be reduced by the scrap value of the old equipment and by any other financial incentives or assistance including tax credits received or expected to be received. The resulting amount is the Incremental Cost. Reimbursement cannot exceed 80% of the Incremental Cost. Eligible costs include the cost of grant funded equipment, taxes, government fees, warranties, and delivery fees.

General requirements:

- The applicant must have continuously owned/leased the existing vehicle and have been listed as the owner on the title or the lessee for the two years immediately preceding the application signature date.
- For on-road projects, grant recipients must agree to operate the grant-funded equipment for 50%,75%, or 100% of the annual and total usage in the nonattainment areas and affected counties.
- The replacement vehicle must be of similar weight class, HP, and type and must continue to perform the same functions as the existing vehicle.
